<b>Description:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Open the color table window</li><li>2. Select the "contoured" color table</li><li>3. Try right-clicking on the color table's control points to change the colors. It won't do it right.</li></ol> <p>If the color table is not in the "equal" mode then things work fine. Note that you can still use the RGBA sliders to change the color even when equal is on.</p>
