Description:	<p>Running VisIt with pyside from a command prompt via > visit -cli -pyside</p> <p>Issuing 'exit()' from the cli causes it to hang. Does not happen from cli without pyside.</p> <p>CTRL-C from cli will close cli but not viewer, but does not affect the hang if you've already issued the 'exit()' command.</p> <p>Can still close by using the 'x' buttons of the windows.</p> <p>This is in the 2.6RC, but cannot select that version yet.</p>
