Description:	<p>cq-id: VisIt00008995 cq-submitter: Mark Miller cq-submit-date: 12/04/09</p> <p>When browsing HDF5 files, if the rc file contains a \$browser_version directive, you wind up getting an error printed to the effect...</p> <p>DBGGetObject: object not found \$browser_version</p> <p>This behavior goes back all the way to 4.5.1 of browser.</p> <p>It does NOT happen on PDB driver because PDB driver does NOT call db_perror when an object it does not recognize is passed. The HDF5 driver does. HDF5 driver behavior is preferred but different from legacy behavior.</p>
