Description:	Ubuntu uses /bin/dash in place of /bin/sh. But, most /bin/sh are really /bin/bash. Most of silo's tests that use scripts work fine on /bin/bash but may contain bash-isms and other non-posix-compliant shell code that will fail on ubuntu. Test everything with dash.
